The following MPRB rec centers are operated through joint partnerships with other organizations. Carl W. Kroening Interpretive Center – Three Rivers Park District offers nature, recreation and local Mississippi River history programs for all ages.

Coyle Community Center – The neighborhood center of the Pillsbury United Communities offers resources and social services, in addition to self-sufficiency, youth and volunteer programs.

Luxton – East Side Neighborhood Services offers programs for recent immigrants and after-school tutoring.

North Commons – YMCA oversees the swimming program at the water park. YWCA offers programs throughout the year.

Peavey – Hope Community works in the Peavey Park Community to make life better for the people that live, work, and play there. Hope Academy (not affiliated with Hope Community) is a charter school that uses Peavey for open play areas and the athletic fields for their teams. In return, the park uses their gym for programming and after-school activities.
